

Immigration Exam, Paperwork, Fee, and Explanation

1. The immigration exam is a specific physical examination that fulfills the USCIS immigration requirement. The I-693 form will be issued in a sealed envelope upon completion.
2. The most up-to-date I-693 is available online (or via our website link). It is recommended to have it filled out (on computer) on the upper section of the 1st page and the name section on the rest of the pages. If filled out by hand, please use only Black ink. The form can also be filled out in our office.
3. For self-paying patients, the charge for this physical exam and administration (for 2 visits) is \$225 per patient. If an extra visit is needed (i.e. 3rd visit), the charge will be an additional \$80 per visit.
4. The lab work for TB and syphilis will require an extra cost, as will any vaccination required. Lab payment will be billed to the patient directly from the lab. If you have had any previous labwork or vaccinations done, please bring the records in—they may be usable.
5. Student insurance and traveler's insurance does not cover this service. We cannot bill insurances for immigration physical exam services.
6. For patients with insurance, we will still require \$225 up front as a deposit, as this exam is not counted as a medical necessity, and insurance may or may not cover this service.
7. We do not charge for vaccinations for patients with insurance, if contracted. These vaccinations are often considered prevention, and we can bill insurance for these.
8. Upon request, we will bill insurance, We will refund money to your residence upon verifying your mailing address through email ASAP upon receiving payment. You may receive notification of this payment earlier than we do through your insurance EOB. Please contact us to ensure early processing of your refund.
9. We will use Wells Fargo Bank Bill-Pay to send the refund check. The refund check should be delivered within 10 days after our confirming mailing address. Please cash the check ASAP—Bill Pay will cancel any uncashed check after 90 days.
